

STATE OF NEVADA**CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined:

The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW¼ NW¼ Section 33, T.20S., R.62E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 33, bears N. 73° 47' 12" W., a distance of 612.24 feet, situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Owner of record: **Downeast, LLC**

Source: **Underground**

Manner of use: **Quasi-Municipal and Domestic**

Amount of appropriation: **0.00244 c.f.s. but not to exceed 1.0 acre-foot annually.**

Period of use: **January 1st through December 31st of each year**

Date of priority: **April 10, 1944***

Description of the works of diversion and the manner and place of use:


Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 100 feet deep, 8-inch diameter casing, equipped with a 5 H.P. Hayes pump and totalizing meter, thence through a distribution system for quasi-municipal and domestic water service for landscaping and fire protection at a child daycare business within a portion of the NW¼ NW¼ Section 33, T.20S., R.62E., M.D.B.&M., being further described as Assessor's Parcel Number 140-33-101-016, Clark County, Nevada.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and specifically subject to the following term:

***This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 64851, which changed the manner of use of a portion of Permit 11101, Certificate 3117; therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 11101, Certificate 3117.**

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
