

STATE OF NEVADA**CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined:

The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW¼ NE¼ Section 14 (unsurveyed), T.37N., R.30E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of Section 31, T.37N., R.31E., M.D.B.&M., bears S.26°31'21" E. a distance of 18,702 feet, situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Owner of record: **DeLong Ranches, Inc.**

Source: **Forgotten Spring**

Manner of use: **Stockwater**

Amount of appropriation: **0.01 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 300 head of cattle, but not to exceed 6.72 acre-feet annually**

Period of use: **January 1st through December 31st of each year**

Date of priority: **October 22, 2013**


Description of the works of diversion and the manner and place of use:

The natural discharge from Forgotten Spring (an unimproved spring) is diverted via a natural pond where 300 head of cattle water within the SW¼ NE¼ Section 14 (unsurveyed), T.37N., R.30E., M.D.B.&M., being within the Jackson Mountain Grazing Allotment.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
