CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, BESSIE ROSEVEAR SHANNON and ED HALSTEAD has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Norahs Spring through pipeline and troughs for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 4, T. 15 N., R. 58 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point that bears East 5480 ft. from the SW. Cor. Sec. 32 T. 16 N., R. 58 E., M.D.B.&M. situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.009 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 1200 sheep and 40 cattle.
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation November 27, 1926

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:-
Water conveyed from the spring through 90 ft. of 2 inch pipe to 100 ft. of galvanized iron troughs. Place of use is in Lot 4, Sec. 4, T. 15 N., R. 58 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
