CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, BESSIE ROSEVEAR SHANNON and ED HALSTEAD has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Paul Spring

through pipeline and tanks for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 17, T. 16 N., R. 58 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point which bears S. 37° 00' E., 2200 ft. from the NW. Cor. of said Sec. 17. situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Bessie Rosevear Shannon and Ed Halstead

Post-office address: Duckwater, Nevada.

Amount of appropriation: .009 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 1200 head of sheep and 40 head of cattle.

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: November 27, 1926

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:-

Thirty feet of 2 inch iron pipe used to convey water from the spring into an iron tank 5 feet in diameter and 2 ft. deep. Place of use in SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 17, T. 16 N., R. 58 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
