CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Adams-McGill Co. by W. Y. McGill has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Giroux Wash

through Giroux Wash Reservoir No. 2 for

Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Approximately SW 1/4 SE 1/4

Sec. 13, T. 15 N., R. 61 E. M.D.B.&M. unsurveyed or at a point which bears S. 20° 30' W. 16,150 ft from SE cor. Sec. 36 T. 16 N. R. 61 E. M.D.B.&M. situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Adams-McGill Company, Incorporated

Post-office address Ely, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.05 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 10,000 sheep

Period of use, from May 1 to October 30 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation March 15, 1928

Description of Works of diversion, manner and place of use:

An earth dam 80 ft. long, 6 ft. high, 50 ft. wide at base and 15 ft. wide at top constructed across wash forming reservoir for watering range livestock. The overflow water is conveyed by ditch around dam back into wash. Place of use approximately SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 13, T. 15 N., R. 61 E. M.D.B.&M. unsurveyed.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
