CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, C. E. Kent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from North Lee Spring through pipeline and troughs for stockwatering and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: approximately SE 1/4 Sec. 29, T. 20 N., R. 33 E. M.D.B.&M. unsurveyed or at a point which bears N. 49° 35' E. 3570 ft. from cor. No. 2 of what is known as David M. Sanford possessory claim situated in Churchill County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Kent Land & Livestock Company

Post-office address Stillwater, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.0375 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 3000 sheep, 500 cattle & 100 horses.

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation September 14, 1928

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water conveyed from spring through 10 feet of 1 1/2 inch pipe to five troughs, each one foot wide, one foot high and eight feet long; with reservoirs constructed below the troughs to catch the overflow. Place of use approximately in the SE 1/4 Sec. 29, T. 20 N., R. 33 E. M.D.B.&M. unsurveyed.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
