CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Fred W. Cook by H. M. Payne has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Underground Source (A Well)

through well, pipeline and ditches for

Irrigation and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 35, T. 14 N., R. 19 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point which bears S. 19° 56' W., 9275 ft. from 1/4 corner on E. boundary Sec. 23, T. 14 N., R. 19 E., M.D.B.&M. situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Description of land to which water is appurtenant:

Part of the land to which water is appurtenant under this certificate is irrigated under a claim of vested right from the Carson River and part from a mountain stream flowing from James Canyon, the water from the well being used to supplement the flow from these sources during those periods of any season when the supply from same is inadequate to properly irrigate the land.
