CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, J. G. Clark has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Imigrant Springs

through Pipelines for

Mining, milling and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: In the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 29, Township 25 N., Range 25 E., M.D.B. & M., or at points from which the N.W. Corner of said Section 29 bears N. 7° 56' W., N. 32° 55' W., N. 46° 55' W., N. 73° 08' W., 1481 feet, 1727 feet, 1078 feet and 1072 feet, respectively situated in Pershing County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 128, Statutes of 1931 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Gold, Silver & Tungsten, Inc.

Post-office address Boulder, Colorado

Amount of appropriation 0.25 c.f.s.

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation February 23, 1935

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:-

Water developed by means of four cribbed wells, all 4 feet by 6 feet inside dimensions and approximately 35 feet deep, with cross drifts. Pumps have been installed at the points of diversion and water pumped through about 1550 feet of 2 inch pipe and 650 feet of 3 inch pipe to a 130,000 gallon redwood tank. Water is thence pumped through about 6600 feet of 3 inch pipe to a 130,000 gallon redwood tank located directly above the mill. Water is conveyed from the main pipeline through about 300 feet of 2 inch pipe for camp use. Places of use are in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 25, Township 25 N., Range 24 E. and the W $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 30, Township 25 N., Range 25 E., M.D.B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
