CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Joseph Flynn has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground source (Rye Patch Well) through Well, siphon pipeline and troughs for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Approximately SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 34, Township 26 N., Range 52 E., M.D.B. & M., unsurveyed, or at a point from which the S.E. Corner of Section 34, Township 27 N., Range 52 E. M.D.B. & M., bears N. 3° 54' E., 28,634 feet distant situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 128, Statutes of 1931 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.013 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 400 cattle and 20 horses
Period of use, from April 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation July 17, 1935

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:-
Dug well 6 feet square, 18 feet deep, timbered with cedar posts. Water siphoned from well through 800 feet of 3/4 inch pipe to two heavy iron troughs, one trough 16 feet long, 26 inches wide and 24 inches deep, and the other 11 feet long, 5 feet wide and 18 inches deep. Water at troughs controlled by float valve with well serving as storage reservoir.
Place of use in approximately the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 34, Township 26 N., Range 52 E., M.D.B. & M., unsurveyed.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
