CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Mrs. Floyd (Alvira) Walch has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Clay Spring through Reservoir for Domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: In the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 7, Township 2 N., Range 57 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point that bears S. 52° 05' W., 2,750 feet from the N.E. Corner of said Section 7 situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 128, Statutes of Nevada, as amended 1931 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.025 c.f.s.  
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year  
Date of priority of appropriation December 4, 1934

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:-  
Water developed by means of an open cut approximately 30 feet long, 3 1/2 feet wide and having an average depth of about 10 feet. Water is impounded in this open cut and dipped out when used. Place of use is in the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 7, Township 2 N., Range 57 E., M.D.B. & M.

\* This amended certificate is issued to correct the location of the point of diversion from Lincoln County to Nye County.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
