CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Van O. Eastland, by J. T. McWilliams, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground source

through pipeline and ditches for Domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: In the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 26, Township 21 S., Range 61 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the N.W. Corner of said Section 26 bears N. 77° 18' W., 776.5 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of Nevada, as amended, 1913 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.033 c.f.s.

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation April 14, 1930

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:-

Artesian well 500 feet deep with 3-inch casing and control valve.

Water is used for household, small garden and general domestic

uses. Place of use is in the said NE 1/4 NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 26.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
