

THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, W. W. Blakeslee, Engineer has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Easter Spring

through pipeline for Domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: In the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 28, Township 14 N., Range 59 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the S. $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner of said Section 28 bears S. 48° 30' E., 1,188 feet situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator United States Forest Service

Post-office address Ogden, Utah

Amount of appropriation 0.011 c.f.s. or 8 acre-feet per year

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation April 4, 1938

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:-

Water is collected into a concrete headbox at the spring from which point it is conveyed through 195 feet of 2 inch and 819 feet of 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe to Ranger Station, where it is used for domestic purposes and the incidental irrigation of lawn around dwelling. Place of use is in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 28, Township 14 N., Range 59 E., M.D.B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
