CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Edwin M. Dawes has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground Source through Pipeline for Milling and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: In the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 34, Township 34 N., Range 30 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the S.E. Corner of said Section 34 bears S. 4° 11' E., 1,109 feet situated in Pershing County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 128, Statutes of 1931 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
* Date of priority of appropriation September 22, 1931

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:-
Water developed by a 4 foot by 5 foot shaft 35 feet deep and diverted by a centrifugal pump powered by gasoline engine and conveyed through about 400 feet of 2 inch pipeline to a 3,000 gallon storage tank at mill. Water also piped to boarding house and dwellings. Place of use is in the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 34, Township 34 N., Range 30 E., M.D.B. & M.

* This application was made to change the point of diversion and place of use under Application No. 9529, hence takes the priority of said Application No. 9529.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
