CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, J. W. Solen has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Clear Creek Springs and Creek, East Fork through Small pond for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: In the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 10, Township 33 N., Range 39 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the S. E. Corner of Section 16, Township 33 N., Range 39 E., bears S. 9° 54' W., 7,422 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 128, Statutes of 1931 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.032 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 1,000 cattle
Period of use, from March 1st to November 1st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation September 11, 1934

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:-
Water diverted at source by natural rock conduit and dam and stored in basin built of rocks immediately adjacent to source. Place of use is in the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 10, Township 33 N., Range 39 E., M.D.B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used; not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
