

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, William F. Cockrell has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Cherry Creek and Springs through Small reservoir for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: In the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 12, Township 37 N., Range 19 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the N. 1/4 corner of said Section 12 bears N. 78° 30' W., 1,835 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation; together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Eagleville, California
Amount of appropriation 0.002 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 75 head of cattle and horses
Period of use, from April 1st to December 1st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation April 23, 1928

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:-
Water from source impounded in a small reservoir formed by a rock and earth dam two feet high and twenty-two feet long located about eighty feet below the head of Cherry Creek Spring. Place of use is in the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 12, Township 37 N., Range 19 E., M.D.B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
