CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, John H. Bergmann has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Engle Spring

through Pipeline

for

Mining and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows, Approximately in the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 31, Township 40 N., Range 36 E., M.D.B. & M., unsurveyed, or at a point from which the S.E. Corner of Section 32, Township 41 N., Range 36 E., M.D.B. & M., bears N. 19° 20' E., 29,823 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 128, Statutes of 1931

has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation September 29, 1936

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:-

Water developed by means of a small shaft about ten feet deep, from which water is conveyed through about one hundred feet of pipeline to five barrels. Place of use is in approximately the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 31, Township 40 N., Range 36 E., M.D.B. & M., unsurveyed.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
