CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, E. R. Sans, Refuge Manager, Biological Survey, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from
Martinez Spring

through pipeline and troughs for
stockwatering (watering of antelope, deer, and other wild life)

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 6, Township 43 N., Range 25 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the E. $\frac{1}{2}$ Corner of said Section 6 bears S. 64° 30' E. 600 feet.

situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 128, Statutes of Nevada, 1931, has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.055 c.f.s.

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation April 13, 1932

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:-
Spring walled in with rock and surrounded with a wire fence. Water is conveyed from spring by 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ inch pipe to ten metal sheep troughs for watering approximately 2,000 antelope, mule deer and other wild life. Place of use is in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 6, Township 43 N., Range 25 E., M.D.B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
