CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Black Mammoth Consolidated Mining Com-pany, by A. N. Sweet of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Silver Peak Spring

through pipeline for Mining, milling and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 22, Township 2 S., Range 39 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point which bears S. 62° 10' E. 1,970 feet from the North $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner of said Section 22 situated in Esmeralda County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 128, Statutes of 1931 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator. Black Mammoth Consolidated Mining Company.

Post-office address. Tonopah, Nevada

Amount of appropriation. 0.334 c.f.s.

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation. October 10, 1936

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:-
Sump at spring 100 feet long, 20 feet wide and 10 feet deep, from which water is conveyed through 10 inch suction pipe to two electrically driven centrifugal pumps set in steel tank below water level of sump. Water pumped under pressure of 1100 pounds per square inch through approximately 25,120 feet of 4 inch pipe to mine and mill located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 6, Township 2 S., Range 39 E., M.D.B. & M., where it is used for mining, milling and domestic purposes.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
