CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, W. H. Settelmeyer, for The Town of Carlin has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground source through well, pump and pipelines for Municipal purposes.

The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: in the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 27, Township 33 N., Range 52 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point which bears N. 60° 12' W., 891 feet from the South 1/2 Corner of said Section 27 situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 128, Statutes of Nevada, 1931 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation September 7, 1934

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:-
Water developed by means of well 50 feet deep, 20 inches in diameter, equipped with 12 inch deep well turbine pump driven by 30 H.P. motor. Water pumped directly into mains of municipal water distribution system of The Town of Carlin located in Section 27 and the W 1/2 W 1/2 of Section 26, Township 33 N., Range 52 E., M.D.B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
