CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, R. B. Day, acting for J.H. Day Estate, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from
Underground source (Artesian Well)

through Ditches for
Irrigation and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: In the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 27, Township 13 N., Range 23 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point that bears N. 51° 19' W. 1955 feet from the S.E. Corner of said Section 27 situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation; together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from March 1st to November 1st of each year

3.86 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 27, Township 13 N., Range 23 E., M.D.B. & M.
3.86 acres total

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
