CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Earl F. Hanson, Engineer for Applicant, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from  
An Underground Source  
through Tunnel and Pipeline for  
Mining

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 1, Township 42 N., Range 51 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the N.  $\frac{1}{4}$  Corner of said Section 1 bears N. 25° 04' W., 3,216.3 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Lime Mountain Consolidated  
Post-office address: Salt Lake City, Utah  
Amount of appropriation: 0.0415 c.f.s.  
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year  
Date of priority of appropriation: July 22, 1938

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:-  
Water is piped within tunnel through 1,000 feet of 2 inch pipe.  
Approximately 200 feet of 3/4 inch pipe distributes water to mine plant buildings located near the tunnel portal in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 1, Township 42 N., Range 51 E., M.D.B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used; not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
