CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Earl F. Hanson, Engineer for Applicant, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Lime Mountain Spring

through Pipelines

for

Domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 6, Township 42 N., Range 52 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the S. $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner of said Section 6 bears S. 87° 19' E., 2,565.1 feet

situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937

has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.02673 c.f.s.

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation July 22, 1938

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:-

Water is piped from spring in a southeasterly direction through 290 feet of 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe and then distributed through 615 feet of 3/4 inch pipe to the various buildings, all located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 6, Township 42 N., Range 52 E., M.D.B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
