

THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Earl A. Honrath has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from An Underground Source through Well and Pipelines for Irrigation and Domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: At a point in the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 28, Township 20 S., Range 61 E., M.D.B. & M., from which the S.W. Corner of said Section 28 bears S. 49° 20' W., 2,903.35 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.11 c.f.s. or 79.72 acre-feet per season
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation May 16, 1938

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:-
A well 650 feet deep cased with 402 feet of 6 inch casing and 294 feet of 4 inch casing. The well is controlled by a 6 inch gate valve. Water is distributed through 130 feet of 4 inch pipe, 900 feet of 3 inch pipe and 2,500 feet of 2 inch pipe to 11 acres, divided into acreage plots, in the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 28, Township 20 S., Range 61 E., M.D.B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
