CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, William F. Moon has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source

through Well and pipelines for

Domestic and irrigation of lawns and gardens

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: in the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 23,

Township 20 S., Range 61 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the S.

1/2 Corner of said Section 23 bears S. 41° 53' E., 2,513.4 feet

situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.04 c.f.s.

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation July 11, 1938

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:-

A well 210 feet deep cased with 200 feet of 8 inch casing. Well is reduced to 1 1/2 inch on surface, has a valve and is connected to a centrifugal pump which elevates water to an 1800 gallon tank mounted in a wooden trestle 22 feet high. The water is distributed through 250 feet of 2 inch and 450 feet of 1 inch pipe to the various buildings and garden plots located in Lots 15, 16, 17, 18, 54, 55, 56 and 57, Block 10, Williams Addition to the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, and situate in the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 23, Township 20 S., Range 61 E., M.D.B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
