CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, John H. Conaway and Press W. Duffin, Jr. ^{vs} Administrator of Estate of James Ryan, Deceased, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Delamar Flat West and North Drainage

through a reservoir

for

Stockwatering and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: in the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 35, Township 4 S., Range 63 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the S.E. Corner of said Section 35 bears S. 18° E., 5,280 feet

situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937

has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator John H. Conaway and James Ryan

Post-office address Caliente, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.0055 c.f.s. or 4.0 acre-feet per annum, or sufficient to water 300 head of cattle

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation October 2, 1941

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:-

Water for watering stock is collected in a reservoir dug out of the ground 7 feet deep, 50 feet wide and 300 feet long at the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
