CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, John H. Conaway has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Balm of Gilead Spring

through check dams for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 11, Township 5 S., Range 65 E., M.D.B. & M., unsurveyed, or at a point from which the S.W. Corner of Section 34, Township 4 S., Range 65 E., bears N. 44° 37' W., 8,617 feet. situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: John H. Conaway
Post-office address: Caliente, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.003125 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 100 cattle.
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: September 14th, 1942

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:-
Water is developed by a tunnel 100 feet long. This tunnel has been damaged by floods and the water now seeps to the surface and is impounded by a series of check dams. The entire works are located in the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 11, Township 5 S., Range 65 E., M.D.B. & M., (unsurveyed).

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
