

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, George Ralph has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Wood Spring through Pipeline and reservoir for Stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: in the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 9, Township 38 N., Range 63 E., M.D.B. & M. situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: George, Richard, John and James Ralph and Hilary E. Bradish
Post-office address: Wells, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.009 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 300 head of cattle
Period of use, from: April 1st to December 1st of each year

* Date of priority of appropriation: June 3, 1918

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:-
Water diverted from spring through 150 feet of iron pipe to a concrete trough. Water also runs in open channel to a small reservoir in the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of said Section 9.

* This application was made to change the manner of use under Permit No. 5089, hence this certificate takes the priority of said Permit No. 5089.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
