CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Robert B. Griffith has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Mazey Spring

through Pipelines for

Domestic and recreational

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 1, Township 20 S., Range 56 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the E $\frac{1}{4}$  Corner of Section 36, Township 19 S., Range 56 E., M.D.B. & M., bears N. 17° 51' E., 4,443.4 feet

situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.5 c.f.s.

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation November 14, 1938

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:-

Water is diverted from source through about 4,000 feet of 4 inch wrought iron pipe to a 12,000 gallon tank which also receives water from Rainbow Creek under Forest Service Permit No. 10306. Water is thence conveyed through a distribution system consisting of approximately 2 miles of 2 inch pipeline, about a half mile of pipeline varying in size from 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  inches to 3/4 inch; one 12,000 gallon concrete tank and two metal tanks of capacity 4,000 gallons and 1200 gallons. Places of use being in the N $\frac{1}{2}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ; SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ; W $\frac{1}{2}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 31 and N $\frac{1}{2}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ; N $\frac{1}{2}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 32, Township 19 S., Range 57 E., M.D.B. & M. This certificate of water right represents a one-half interest in Permit No. 10305 originally in the name of Robert B. Griffith and conveyed to the United States Forest Service by deed dated July 6, 1943, in accordance with that certain agreement dated September 26, 1938, between the said Robert B. Griffith and the United States Department of Agriculture, Forest Service.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
