CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, John H. Conaway has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Conaway Spring through reservoir for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: in the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 17, Township 5 S., Range 66 E., M.D.B. & M., unsurveyed, or at a point from which the N.W. Corner of Section 22, Township 5 S., Range 66 E., M.D.B. & M., bears S. 78° 58' E., 6,479 feet situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: John H. Conaway
Post-office address: Caliente, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.0025 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 80 cattle
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: February 15, 1943

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:-
A small reservoir ten feet square and one to one and one half feet deep with a small check dam which forms a pond from which the cattle drink.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
