CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Conception Saval has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground source through wells and pipelines for placer mining and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: in the unsurveyed NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 26, Township 34 N., Range 29 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the N.E. Corner of Section 2, Township 32 N., Range 29 E., M.D.B. & M., bears S. 6° 41' E., 39,686 feet situated in Pershing County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 1.075 c.f.s.

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation December 15, 1938

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:-
Water developed by means of two wells, Well No. 1 being 303 feet deep and cased with 178 feet of 12 inch casing and Well No. 2 being 115 feet deep with 6 inch casing. Both wells are equipped with Pomona pumps powered by gas engines. Water is pumped from wells through 4 inch pipelines to storage tanks and thence conveyed to sluice boxes for placer operations. Places of use are in the unsurveyed SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 26, Township 34 N., Range 29 E., M.D.B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
