CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Angelo C. Florio, Rancher has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Secret Canyon Springs (Murray Spring)

through pipeline and troughs for

Stockwatering and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: in the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 14, Township 18 N., Range 53 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the N.E. Corner of Section 18, Township 18 N., Range 54 E., M.D.B. & M., bears N. 87° 38' E., 14,264 feet situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 149, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Angelo C. Florio

Post-office address: Eureka, Nevada

Amount of appropriation: 0.05 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 8,000 sheep

Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: December 20, 1930

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:-

Water developed by means of a 25 foot tunnel and conveyed through 75 feet of 2 inch pipeline to three wood troughs, each 1 foot by 1 foot by 12 feet long. Place of use is in the said NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 14, Township 18 N., Range 53 E., M.D.B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
