CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, H. J. Plumhof, General Manager, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from _____
An underground source
through Well and pipelines for _____
Railroad and domestic
purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 10, Township 39 N., Range 63 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the N.E. Corner of Section 3, Township 39 N., Range 63 E. bears N. 19° 55' E., 6,043 feet,
situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 128, Statutes of 1931 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 1.0 c.f.s.

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation March 2, 1936

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:-

A drilled well 212 feet deep cased with 12 inch casing. A deep well pump driven by a 10 HP engine delivers water to a 50,000 gallon capacity tank. From the tank the water is distributed through mains for locomotive, train and stock pen use. The place of use is in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 10, Township 39 N., Range 63 E., M.D.B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
