CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Frank McGregor has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Martin Creek through Canal and reservoir for Mining

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: In the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 28, Township 45 N., Range 56 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the S.W. Corner of said Section 28 bears S. 52° 10' W., 4,892 feet, situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 128, Statutes of 1931 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Frank McGregor
Post-office address: 2912 Adams Avenue, Ogden, Utah
Amount of appropriation: 1500 acre-feet
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: July 6, 1934

Description of works of diversion, manner and places of use:-

Water is diverted from source by means of a masonry dam with weir and conveyed through approximately eight miles of canal to Gold Creek Reservoir. Said canal, known as Gold Creek Canal, is eight feet wide and four feet deep and has an average grade of 8/10 inch per 100 feet, and also conveys water from Mill and Big Ben Creeks to the Gold Creek Reservoir under Permits Nos. 9796, 9797, 9954 and 9955. Reservoir formed by two dams, the South dam being about 700 feet long and 50 feet high and the Northwest dam being about 1200 feet long and 25 feet high, and has a capacity of 2,057 acre-feet. Water is released through the South dam by means of a 24 inch pipe and conveyed to places of use by canals and creek channel. Places of use are in portions of Sections 7 and 18, Township 44 N., Range 56 E., and Section 12, Township 44 N., Range 55 E., M.D.B. & M. \*

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
