CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Frank McGregor has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Gold Creek or Hope Gulch through Ditch for Mining and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: In Lot 18, Section 12, Township 44 N., Range 55 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the N.W. Corner of said Section 12 bears N. 40° 38' W., 2,100 feet, situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 128, Statutes of 1931 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation July 9, 1936

Description of works of diversion, manner and places of use:-
Water is diverted from creek channel by means of an earth dam and conveyed to place of use by means of ditches. The waters from this source are intermingled with the waters from Martin, Mill and Big Ben Creeks under Permits Nos. 9768, 9796, 9797, 9954 and 9955 for placer mining purposes in portions of Sections 7 and 18, Township 44 N., Range 56 E., and Section 12, Township 44 N., Range 55 E., M.D.B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
