CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, P. J. Goumond has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

An underground source (Las Vegas Artesian Basin) through drilled well and pipeline for Swimming pool

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: In the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 34, Township 20 S., Range 61 E., M.D.B. & M., (Lot 26, Block 5, Wardie Addition to Las Vegas), and at a point from which the S. 1/4 Corner of said Section 34 bears S. 11° 45' W., 2,086 feet, situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: P. J. Goumond
Post-office address: Las Vegas, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.05 c.f.s.
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: January 24, 1940

Description of Works of diversion, manner and place of use:-
Water developed by means of a 6-inch drilled well 638 feet deep cased with 475 feet of 5-5/8 inch and 163 feet of 4 inch I.D. casing. Water flows under hydrostatic pressure to a concrete swimming pool 20 feet by 40 feet by 5.5 feet deep which drains into the Las Vegas sewer system. Place of use is in the said NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 34, Township 20 S., Range 61 E., M.D.B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
