CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS W. J. Henley, Secretary, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Gold Canyon Creek through ditch and wooden flume for Tailings Disposal

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: In the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 23, Township 16 N., Range 21 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the N. 1/4 Corner of said Section 23 bears N. 26° 22' E., 3,255 feet, situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

- Name of appropriator: South Comstock Tailings Disposal Company
- Post-office address: Virginia City, Nevada
- Amount of appropriation: 3.0 c.f.s.
- Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
- Date of priority of appropriation: April 8, 1938

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:-  
Tailings from natural channel of Gold Canyon Creek and diverted by means of an earth and rock dam at the point of diversion and conveyed by means of ditch and wooden flume to tailings pond located in the S 1/2 SE 1/4 of Section 14 and portions of the N 1/2 NE 1/4 of Section 23, Township 16 N., Range 21 E., M.D.B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
