Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from September 1st to May 31st of ~~each~~ year

Date of priority of appropriation January 4, 1940

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:-

Water impounded by means of a reservoir 125 yards by 10 yards wide and 5 feet deep constructed at point of diversion. Stock water from reservoir. Place of use is in the said NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 7, Township 11 S., Range 61 E., M.D.B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
