CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Earl and Gerald Leavitt and Nettie Wittwer has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from An underground source through ditches for Irrigation and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: In the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 6, Township 21 S., Range 61 E., M.D.B. & M., or at points from which the East 1/2 Corner of said Section 6 bears S. 89° 17' 30" E. 2,632 feet; S. 81° 23' E. 2,329 feet, and S. 87° 52' E. 2,318 feet, and being wells Nos. 21, 22 and 148 as designated by the State Engineer, Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937

has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Description of lands to which water is appurtenant:-

20 acres in the S 1/2 SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 6, Township 21 S., Range 61 E., M.D.B. & M.  
20 acres total

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
