CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS F. B. O'Leary, Engineer and Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Unnamed Spring

through Pipeline and troughs for

Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: In the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 5, Township 45 N., Range 39 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the S.W. Corner of Section 32, Township 46 N., Range 39 E., bears N. 33° 00' W., 4,852 feet, situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Henry McCleary Timber Company

Post-office address Winnemucca, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.0072 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 230 head of cattle

Period of use, from April 1st to November 1st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation December 30, 1938

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:-

Trench excavation into spring; digging out and walling up the spring basin; trenching for and laying 50 feet of 2 inch pipe to convey water to two steel troughs 12 feet long by 4 feet wide by 1 1/2 feet deep.

Place of use is in the said SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 5, Township 45 N., Range 39 E., M.D.B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
