CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, James Hunter has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Simpson No. 2 Spring

through Pipeline and reservoir for

Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: In the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 27, Township 19 N., Range 54 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the N.W. Corner of Section 22, Township 19 N., Range 54 E., bears N. 23° 30' W., 9,380 feet, situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator James Hunter

Post-office address Eureka, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.0063 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 200 head of cattle

Period of use, from May 1st to October 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation July 3, 1943

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:-

Water developed by running a ditch 15 feet into a seep and conveyed by a short length of pipe to a reservoir 35 feet long, 2 feet wide formed by a dam 6 feet high. Place of use is in the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 27, Township 19 N., Range 54 E., M.D.B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
