CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Richard R. Stadelman has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground (Las Vegas Artesian Basin) through pipe line for Quasi - Municipal

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: In the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 27, T. 21 S., R. 62 E., M.D.M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said section 27 bears N. 22° 46' W., 2443.6', situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 - has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation March 11, 1941

Description of Works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water diverted from an artesian well 450' deep, having a 6" casing by means pump and conveyed to an overhead storage tank, thence thru approximately 600' of pipe lines varying in size from 2" to 1/2" to various places of use in Tract 46 of the Whitney subdivision in the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 27, T. 21 S., R. 62 E. M.D.M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
