CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, T. O. McKinnon has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Wild Horse Spring

through pipeline and troughs for

Stockwatering and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: In the SW NE Section 33, T. 10 N., R. 34 E., M.D.M., or at a point from which the SE corner of Section 31, T. 10 N., R. 34 E., bears S. 72° 30' W., 9050 feet.

situated in Mineral County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator T. O. McKinnon

Post-office address Mina, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.025 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 3000 goats and 30 horses.

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation April 19, 1928

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water developed and impounded by means of a small concrete dam and thence conveyed through pipeline to troughs located near spring and being in the said SW NE Section 33, T. 10 N., R. 34 E., M.D.M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
