CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Jean Etchart Loge has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Anderson Springs through Pipeline for Irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SW 1/4 and NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 7, T37N, R41E, M.D.B. & M. situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Jean Etchart Loge
Post-office address: Golconda, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 2.50 C.F.S. or 756 acre feet per season
Period of use, from April 1 to August 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: June 1, 1914

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
