

THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Henry Filippini has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground (Laborda Well No. 2) through pipe line and troughs for Stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: In the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 12 T. 25 N., R. 42 E., M.D.M. or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 12 bears S 86° 05' E., 3114.0 situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of - 1913 - has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

 Post-office address Battle Mountain, Nevada
 Amount of appropriation 0.012 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 350 cattle & 40 horses
 Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
 Date of priority of appropriation January 7, 1930

Description of Works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water developed by means of a cased well 110' deep. Well equipped with a 30' windmill as well as a gasoline pump and pump jack. Water conveyed from well through 12' of 1 1/2" pipe to two storage tanks, one 10' high by 16' wide and one 8' high by 6' wide; thence through 10' of 1" pipe to a small round metal trough. Place of use is in the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 12, T. 25 N. R. 42 E., M.D.M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
