

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, W. W. Whitaker has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Jack Spring through pipe line for Stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: In the SE NW and NE SW Section 10, T. 13 N., R. 37 E., M.D.M. or at points from which the approximate center of said Section 10 bears S 23° 50' E. 1095' and N 36° 10' E. 80' respectively situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of Nevada, 1937, has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.0234 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 750 head of cattle and horses.
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation December 15, 1938

Description of Works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water diverted from spring in NE SW Section 10 through 68' of 2" pipe to two G. I. tanks 6' in diameter and 2 1/2' deep and 8' in diameter and 3' deep. Diversion from spring in the SE NW Section 10 is through 1300' of 2 1/8" and 1" pipe to three G. I. tanks of the following sizes at corrals: 2' x 20' x 15" deep, 8 1/2' x 4' x 2' deep and 6' in diameter by 3' deep. Places of use are in the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 and NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 10, T. 13 N., R. 37 E., M.D.M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
