CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, A.G. McBride, Stockraiser has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground (McBride Long Valley Well No) through pipe line and troughs for Stockwatering and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: In the SE¹/₄ SE¹/₄ Section 21 T. 22 N. R. 58 E., M.D.M. or at a point from which the NE corner of Section 9. T. 21 N. R. 58 E., bears S 1° 19' E., 16,074.00 feet situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator A.G. McBride
Post-office address Elko, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.032 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 5000 head of sheep
Period of use, from Jan. 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation March 18, 1930

Description of Works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water developed by means of a 4" Well 150' deep. Well equipped with a 3 H.P. gasoline engine and water is pumped into a 750 gallon tank, thence to 250' of sheep watering troughs, having a total capacity of 2000 gallons. Place of use is in the SE¹/₄ SE¹/₄ Section 21, T. 22 N. R. 58 E., M.D.M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
