

# THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, E. L. Cord has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground (Well No. 5) through ditches for Irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: In the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 34, T. 2 S., R. 35 E., M.D.M., or at a point from which the N $\frac{1}{4}$  corner of Section 33, T. 2 S., R. 35 E., bears N 51° 36' W., 4118 feet. situated in Esmeralda County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

 Amount of appropriation 0.40 c.f.s. or 134 acre feet per season  
 Period of use, from Mar. 15th to Oct. 1st of each year  
 Date of priority of appropriation December 27, 1944

Description of Works of diversion, manner and place of use:  
Water developed by means of a drilled well, 12" in diameter and 100' deep, equipped with a 15 H.P. electrical driven Pomona deep well turbine pump and is used as a supplemental water supply on 21.42 acres of land in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 34, T. 2 S., R. 35 E., having a decreed right from Leidy Creek and as a new supply on 18.58 acres in the said NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 34.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
