CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS E. L. Cord has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground (Well No. 8) through ditches for Irrigation

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: In the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 34, T. 2 S., R. 35 E., M.D.M. or at a point from which the NE Corner of said section 34 bears N 33° 47' E., 2337.00 feet. situated in Esmeralda County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation December 27, 1944

Description of Works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water developed by means of a drilled well 12" in diameter and 50' deep, equipped with a windmill, Aeromotor type, and is used to supplement decreed water from Leidy Creek on 10 acres of land in the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 34, T. 2 S., R. 35 E., M.D.M. from May 1st to October 1st of each year and as a new appropriation from October 1st to May 1st of the following year on said 10 acres.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
