CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, E. O. Underhill, Merchant has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground (Las Vegas Artesian Basin) through pipelines for irrigation and domestic purposes purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: In the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 3, T. 21 S., R. 61 E., M.D.M., or at a point from which the W 1/2 corner of said section 3 bears N. 53° 06' W. 672 feet. situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.05 c.f.s.

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation April 5, 1941

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water developed by means of a 4" artesian well 560' deep. Well is equipped with a Fairbanks-Morse electric driven pump and pressure tank. Water distributed through approximately 160' of 1" pipe and 150' of 1/2" pipe to places of use on a 4 acre tract of land in the said NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 3, T. 21 S., R. 61 E., M.D.M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
