

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Vernon E. Bunker has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground (Well No. 6) through pipe line for Stockwatering and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: In the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 23, T. 3 S., R. 55 E., M.D.M., or at a point from which the S.E. corner of Section 31, T. 3 S., R. 55 E., bears S. 49° 15' E., 17,055 feet, situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.0094 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 300 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation July 16, 1945

Description of WORKS of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water developed by means of a 120 foot steel cased well equipped with a 10 foot Aermoter windmill. Water is pumped from well through a 2 inch pipe to a 1250 gallon storage tank, 150 feet of galvanized watering trough and a reservoir. Place of use is in the said SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 23, T. 3 S., R. 55 E., M.D.M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
